Three simple main rules:

- 1. Free to enter and open to all amateur photographers whether BSBI members or not.
- 2. Photographs must be taken in Britain or Ireland but not necessarily in the competition year. So, images could be from back-catalogues.
- 3. Photographs should be of any native or alien flowering plant, conifer, fern, horsetail, club-moss or stonewort *growing in the wild (i.e. not a garden)*.

Full Competition Rules

Plants in winter, spring, summer and autumn
